## BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Mohammad Naficy was born in Tehran in 1941. He studied Television Production at San Francisco State College, where he received an M.A. degree in 1970. Immediately after completion of his studies he returned to Tehran. He was employed by National Iranian Radio and Television Organization. During the seventies he worked within that organization as producer, director of Family and Children's program, teacher at the television school, and director of broadcasting. Through his work with Shiraz Art Festival, as well as through his regular duties, he was able to work closely with artists and technicians in every area of film and theater production. Mr. Naficy's recollections shed light on the workings of the television industry, the achievements and the problems of NIRT, handling of political and security issues, dealing with censorship, as well as the day to day business of planning, production and broadcasting of a daily program.

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
