#### BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Ms. Parvin Mo'ayyed-Sabeti was born in Tehran, and lived much of her life in Mashhad. Since young age she became active in womens circles in Khorasan, and later became one of the founding members of the Womens Organization of Iran. She also served as the Director of the Youth Centers, established under the direction of the Prime Minister's Office. In 1974 she was charged with the task of supervising the construction of Tehran's olympic village in preparation for the Asian Games. Her renditions shed much light on women's affairs in Iran, and the woking of the bureaucracy and the various government institutions.
